UPDATED INFORMATION REGARDING INTERPRETING YOUR COVID ANTIGEN TEST DONE USING THE SOFIA TESTING PROGRAM (this is an update to the *Fact Sheet for Patients, Sophia SARS Antigen FIA - Quidel Corporation, July 17, 2020*)

CURRENT CDC GUIDELINES

- If your COVID Antigen test is **positive** you need to remain home until **24 hours without a fever** AND symptoms have improved AND 10 days have passed since your symptoms first appeared.
- ★ If your COVID Antigen test is negative it is currently recommended to monitor symptoms and remain home while ill. You may return to activity after 24 hours without a fever AND symptoms have improved. However, if you continue to run a fever or symptoms worsen you should contact your provider's office and plan to return in the next 24-48 hours to repeat testing if the antigen testing was originally used.
